



## 8 Session Course STUDENT Guide

### First 2 ½ hour session:

- 1) Your instructor will provide you with the: Session 1-2 Lesson Review Questions or instruct you how to download them off the course website. (A listing of all the needed documents you need to print out from the website: [www.canadiandriversedge.com](http://www.canadiandriversedge.com) is on the third page of this guide, do this as soon as possible)  
These review questions will cover the various PowerPoint lessons for the entire first day. At the end of each lesson, you will write down the answers in the blanks.
- 2) You need to study these answer sheets in preparation for a 30 question quiz on Session 3. You will need to bring **blank ruled paper** for the various quizzes and tests for the course.
- 3) Student-teacher discussion: Lesson 1 – Rules of the Road – part 1  
Student-teacher discussion: Lesson 2 – Rules of the Road – part 2
- 4) Independent Learning Research Projects:  
Your instructor will explain the projects in class. After a break, you will inform your instructor of your choice. The project is due on Session 7. You will then be required to give a brief written summation of the project and what you learned from it.

### Second 2 ½ hour session:

- 1) Your instructor may show you the course website: [www.canadiandriversedge.com](http://www.canadiandriversedge.com)  
Your instructor will:  
Show you the various PowerPoint lesson titles and corresponding Word Document lesson review questions that you will download, print out and complete outside the classroom. (at home). Your instructor may show you an example, clicking open the lesson: Traffic Laws and Regulations (PowerPoint Lesson) and the corresponding word document.  
When you open this file at home, **print out** these questions and then answer them as you go through the PowerPoint lesson. Don't wait until the end...answer the questions as you go through the presentation.  
**TO ADVANCE THE SLIDE PRESENTATION – CLICK CURSOR ON THE ACTUAL SLIDE**  
After you finish, use the Esc key and or back button to return to the home page.  
When opening the files...you are given the option of opening it or saving it to your computer. Open the file instead of saving it.
- 2) Besides lesson above, **you must also complete the additional listed home link lessons on the website for Sessions 1-2.** These additional assignments are as follows:  
Basic Vehicle Components and Forces of Nature on Vehicle  
  
The assignment sheets for these lessons must be filled out and brought to class on Session 3. Your instructor will collect the lesson sheets and you will be quizzed in Session 3. over these assignments as well as the in-class lessons covered on day 1.
- 3) During this session you will now study: Vehicle Handling: part 1 and part 2.

### **Third 2 ½ hour session:**

- 1) You will show your instructor you have completed the home link web lessons from Sessions 1-2. You will receive 20 points for the completion of the work.
- 2) **Sessions 1-2 Lesson QUIZ** covering Sessions 1-2 lessons and Home link lessons). Number a blank sheet of paper from 1-30. After the quiz, you will exchange papers with another student, correct their paper, then list the point total of correct answers at the top of the page. Instructor will collect the quizzes. With your a perfect quiz score, you can maximize 30 points.
- 3) Instructor will teach the PowerPoint lessons: Vehicle Handling – part 3 and 4
- 4) Your instructor will also provide an explanation of the Student Survey which is due on Session 7.

### **Fourth 2 ½ hour session:**

- 1) Instructor will teach the PowerPoint lessons: Vehicle Handling – part 5 and 6
- 2) Your instructor will remind you to complete the assigned Independent Home Link Learning hours and complete the corresponding lesson review sheets which will be due for the next class. Those home link web lessons are: Respect / Responsibility in Emergency Situations and Driving Behaviour and Controlling Emotions. Your instructor will assign the Parental Rules of the Road Review. You'll go through this with a parent.

### **Fifth 2 ½ hour session:**

- 1) **Sessions 3-4 Lesson QUIZ** covering Sessions 3-4 lessons and Home link lessons). Number a blank sheet of paper from 1-30. After the quiz, you will exchange papers with another student, correct their paper, then list the point total of correct answers at the top of the page. Instructor will collect the quizzes. With a perfect quiz score, you can maximize 30 points.
- 2) Instructor teaches PowerPoint lessons: Attention – part 1 and 2

### **Sixth 2 ½ hour session:**

- 1) Instructor teaches PowerPoint lesson: Attention – part 3  
**Rules of Road PowerPoint TEST** (test corrected in class (exchange papers))
- 2) Traffic Survey small group discussion findings
- 2) You will be reminded to complete the assigned Independent Home Link Learning hours and complete the corresponding lesson review sheets for this lesson: Respect / Responsibility for the Environment. REMEMBER TO STUDY ALL review sheets for the 2 major TESTS you will take in sessions 7 and 8.

## Seventh 2 ½ hour session:

- 1) **Sessions 5-6 Lesson QUIZ** covering Sessions 5-6 lessons and Home link lessons). Number a blank sheet of paper from 1-30. After the quiz, you will exchange papers with another student, correct their paper, then list the point total of correct answers at the top of the page. Instructor will collect the quizzes. With a perfect quiz score, you can maximize 30 points.
- 2) Instructor teaches lesson: *Perception and Risk Management*  
**Vehicle Handling TEST** (75 questions) correct in class
- 3) Instructor will collect the Experiential Research Projects.

## Eighth 2 ½ hour session:

- 1) Play review games: (divide class in 2 teams)
- 2) Responsible Driver TEST (100 questions) and correct in class. This is a written test. You are allowed 1 hour complete. You will also be given a summation “test” on the Experiential learning project you completed and a course evaluation.
