## **Teen/Parent Driving Contract**

Parents and teenage drivers should take time to review the issues, privileges and responsibilities associated with driving. State how each issue will be handled in your household. Then make an agreement about compliance with that rule. *For example:* 

## Issue: Using drugs or alcohol; taking a ride with someone who is under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

- Rule: I will not use alcohol or other drugs. It is against the law. I will not put my life in danger by riding with anyone who has used alcohol or drugs.
- Agreement: If I ever ride in a car where anyone, including me has used alcohol or drugs I will be allowed to drive only with my parents for 6 months.
